Traffic Management

This document serves as a guide for workers (including contractors) at Indara, outlining the minimum criteria and practices required when planning and executing activities involving traffic management. This guide outlines the criteria that Indara requires to be effectively addressed and managed during the planning and execution of commissioned work activities. Workers are expected to integrate these criteria into their Health Safety Environment Quality (HSEQ) management systems and plans. As a minimum, Indara anticipates evidence of adherence to these criteria in workers' HSEQ management systems and plans.

CRITERIA FOR TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ACTIVITIES

RESPONSIBILITIES AND AUTHORITIES

Designated individuals are assigned responsibilities and authorities for managing and supervising traffic management activities.

IDENTIFICATION OF INTERACTIONS AND RISKS

Interactions between traffic, plant, workers, and pedestrians must be identified, and associated hazards, risks, and mitigation strategies must be documented, regularly reviewed, and easily accessible to workers. All individuals involved in activities detailed in a Safe Work Method Statement (SWMS) must sign onto the relevant SWMS.

COMPETENT TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT PLANS

Competent individuals must develop traffic management plans or traffic guidance schemes that are specific to the worksite. These plans should be readily available for reference.

COMPLIANCE WITH PERMITS

Relevant traffic authority permits required for the worksite must be obtained and readily available on-site. These permits must adhere to legislative and codes of practice requirements.

COMPETENT TRAFFIC CONTROLLERS

Individuals assigned traffic control duties must be trained and competent to perform their tasks effectively.

SAFETY OF TRAFFIC CONTROLLERS

Traffic controllers must be provided with the highest level of protection, following the hierarchy of control principles.

DISTRACTION MINIMISATION

Effective rules must be established and enforced to minimise distractions for traffic controllers.

WORKSITE INSPECTIONS

Regular worksite inspections must be conducted to ensure compliance with traffic management plans and safe work systems.

This document outlines the essential guidelines for managing traffic within and around the worksite. All persons, including our contractors are expected to incorporate these guidelines into their HSEQ management systems and plans. Compliance with these guidelines is mandatory for all to ensure the safety of personnel and efficient traffic management practices.
